A

BILL

further to amend the National Database and Registration Authority Ordinance, 2000 (Ordinance VIII of 2000).

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the National Database and Registration Authority Ordinance, 2000 (Ordinance VIII of 2000) for the purpose hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

1. **Short title and commencement.**- (1) This Act may be called the National Database and Registration Authority (Amendment) Act, 2010.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 19, Ordinance VIII of 2000.**- In the National Database and Registration Authority Ordinance, 2000 (No. VIII of 2000), in section 19 after sub-section (2), the following new sub-sections (3) and (4), shall be inserted and proceeding sub-sections shall be re-numbered accordingly, namely:-

“(3). Whenever a photocopy of the Computerized National Identity Card is required to be produced with any documents by any authority or person for any purpose, such Computerized National Identity Card shall bear the endorsement with red ink and signature of holder of Computerized National Identity Card about the purpose for which such computerized National Identity Card was annexed.

(4) The photocopy of the Computerized National Identity Card produced with any document shall not be valid for any other purpose except the purpose for which such Computerized National Identity Card was produced.”

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

Now a days the photocopy of Computerized National Identity Cards is frequently required to be annexed with various documents and the same can be mis-used by any person for unlawful gain. Therefore, to control such mis-use of photocopies of Computerized National Identity Cards, the proposed amendment is necessary.

2. The Bill seeks to achieve the aforesaid objective.
