The following Act of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) received the assent of the President on the 2nd February, 1989, and is hereby published for general information :—

ACT NO. III OF 1989

An Act further to amend the Delimitation of Constituencies Act, 1974

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Delimitation of Constituencies Act, 1974 (XXXIV of 1974), for the purposes hereinafter appearing :

It is hereby enacted as follows :—

1. **Short title and commencement.**—(1) This Act may be called the Delimitation of Constituencies (Amendment) Act, 1989.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Amendment of section 2, Act XXXIV of 1974.**—In the Delimitation of Constituencies Act, 1974 (XXXIV of 1974), hereinafter referred to as the said Act, in section 2, in clause (c), for the figure "1972" the words "last preceding" shall be substituted.

3. **Amendment of section 7, Act XXXIV of 1974.**—In the said Act, in section 7,—

- (a) in sub-section (1), for the table the following shall be substituted, namely :—

Provided that the allocation of seats reserved for women shall not be effective after the holding of the third general election to the National Assembly under the Constitution."; and

- (b) after sub-section (1), amended as aforesaid, the following new sub-section shall be added, namely :—

"(2) The seats allocated under sub-section (1) shall be re-allocated after each succeeding census.".

4. Substitution of section 8, Act XXXIV of 1974.—In the said Act, for section 8 the following shall be substituted, namely :—

"8. *Delimitation of constituencies.*—(1) For the purpose of election to the National Assembly, the Commission shall divide—

(a) each Province into as many separate territorial constituencies as the number of Muslim seats allocated to that Province under section 7; and

(b) the Federally Administered Tribal Areas and the Federal Capital into as many territorial constituencies as the number of Muslim seats respectively allocated to the said Areas and the Federal Capital under that section and the delimitation of the said Areas shall be as set out in the Schedule.

(2) For the purpose of election to Provincial Assemblies, the Commission shall divide each Province into as many territorial constituencies as the number of Muslim seats fixed under clause (1) of Article 106.".

5. Amendment of section 9, Act XXXIV of 1974.—In the said Act, in section 9, in sub-section (1),—

- (a) after the word "constituencies" occurring for the first time, the words "for Muslim seats" shall be inserted and, after the word "population", the commas and words ", including non-Muslims," shall be inserted; and
- (b) the proviso shall be omitted.

6. Amendment of section 10, Act XXXIV of 1974.—In the said Act, in section 10, in sub-section (2), for the word "thirty" the word "fifteen" shall be substituted.

7. Amendment of section 10B, Act XXXIV of 1974.—In the said Act, in section 10B, for the word "Order" the word "Act" shall be substituted.

8. Substitution of the Schedule to Act XXXIV of 1974.—In the said Act, for the Schedule the following Schedule shall be substituted, namely:—

9. Repeal.—The Delimitation of Constituencies (Second Amendment) Ordinance, 1988 (VIII of 1988), and the Delimitation of Constituencies (Third Amendment) Ordinance, 1988 (XXIX of 1988), are hereby repealed.
