to repeal the Federal Court Act, 1937

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Federal Court Act. 1937 (XXV of 1937), for the purposes hereinafter appearing:

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- Short title and commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Federal Court (Repeal) Act, 2013.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- Repeal of Act XXV of 1937.- The Federal Court Act, 1937. (XXV of 1937), is hereby repealed.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

The Law and Justice Commission of Pakistan considered the proposal to repeal Federal Court Act, 1937, in its meeting dated 4th June, 2011. It was observed that pursuant to framing of Supreme Court Rules, 1980, the Federal Court Act, 1937 has lost its effectiveness and has become redundant, therefore, there is no need to retain the same. The Commission agreed with the Proposal and recommended to repeal the Federal Court Act, 1937 (Act No. XXV of 1937).
