BILL

further to amend the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan

WHEREAS it is expedient further to amend the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:-

- 1. Short title and commencement.- (1) This Act may be called the Constitution (Amendment) Act, 2015.
 - (2) It shall come into force at once.
- 2. <u>Amendment of Article 63.</u>- In the Constitution of the Islamic Republic of Pakistan, after Article 63 A the following, new Article shall be inserted, namely.-
 - "63B. <u>Disqualification on certain grounds</u>.- (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in the Constitution or any other law for the time being in force, a person shall be disqualified from service in Pakistan or holding any office in any organization, including members of the armed forces and judiciary, whether wholly or partly owned or controlled by the Federal or Provincial Government or being elected or chosen as a member of Majlis-e-Shoora (Parliament) or Provincial Assembly or local government if:
 - (a) he maintains an account in any bank or financial institution in a foreign country whether in his own name, or in the name of his spouse, children or dependents or as the case may be which has not been declared and accounted for; or
 - (b) holds a dual nationality or has a permanent resident status of any other country whether in his own name, or in the name of his spouse, children or dependents or as the case may be; or
 - (c) holds an office of profit or interest in any company or organization established in a foreign country whether in his own name, or in the name of his spouse, children or dependents or as the case may be, which has not been declared or accounted for; or
 - (d) owns any property whether free hold, lease hold or even in the form of license, assets, shares or any interest in any company based in a foreign country, whether in his own name, or in the case may be which has not been decided or a concounted for; and

(e) carries out business including any commercial activity in any organization or establishment based in a foreign country whether in his own name, or in the name of his spouse, children or dependents or as the case may be which has not been declared or accounted for:

Provided that the aforesaid amendment shall be effective after an expiry of one year from the date of commencement of this Act.

STATEMENT OF OBJECTS AND REASONS

This Bill is for the people who have faith in Pakistan and for the people who believe in Pakistan. It will strengthen democracy and its institutions. It is an attempt to preempt a revolting situation which may give rise to turmoil within our country.

This Bill will eradicate the misery of those under privileged who are unaware of their association with their motherland. Situation once again necessitates that we should rise for the resurrection and fulfill the dream of our Quaid and ancestors. We should earn respect, not for ourselves but for our Pakistan.
