MOTION UNDER 244(B)

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs moved the following motion, which was adopted by the House:-

“That under rule 244(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, that a Special Committee may be constituted by the Hon’ble Speaker, comprising members of the National Assembly from Treasury and Opposition Benches to examine the matters relating to agricultural products particularly tobacco in the country. The Hon’ble Speaker may be authorized to make changes in the composition of the Committee as and when required. The committee will present its report to the House.

Amendment in Motion adopted on 21st February, 2019

Mr. Ali Muhammad Khan, Minister of State for Parliamentary Affairs moved the following amendment in the Motion adopted by the House on 21st February, 2019, to appoint a Special Committee on Kashmir, under rule 244(B) of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007:

“In the said Motion in first Paragraph,-

- 1) for the words “Special Committee on Kashmir”, the words “Parliamentary Committee on Kashmir” shall be substituted; and
- 2) at the end after the expression “as and when so required.” the following shall be inserted, namely:-

“The Speaker is also authorized to include six Senators, three from the Treasury and three from the Opposition Parties, based on their strength in the Senate, in consultation with the Chairman Senate. The Chairman and Secretary of the Committee shall be from the National Assembly.”
