

REVISED NOTICE

(Change of date & time)

9th meeting of the **Sub Committee of the Special Committee on Persons with Disabilities (PWDs)** will now be held **on Friday the 26th November, 2021 at 10:30 am instead of Thursday the 25th November, 2021 at 11:00 am in the Constitution Room (old Committee Room No. 5), Second Floor, Parliament House, Islamabad** to discuss the progress made on the following recommendations and decisions of the Sub-Committee of the Special Committee on Persons with Disabilities addressed to the Secretary Commerce on 29th January, 2021. (Copy Enclosed)

1. As informed by the representative of Ministry of Commerce approximately 05 duty free cars for the Disabled Persons are imported in last 03 years, owing to the current strict policy and procedures. Hence, the Ministry shall revisit its policy accordingly, by making it more practical and favorable to the Persons with Disabilities (PWDs).
 2. PWDs should be allowed to import used vehicles up to 08 years instead of only the fresh one's which are very expensive and beyond the range (purchasing power) of the PWDs.
 3. PWDs should be allowed to import vehicle up to 2000 cc instead of 1350 cc.
 4. PWDs should be allowed to import car for the commercial use as well, so they are empowered financially. (Uber, Careem, Taxi etc. to be driven only by the PWDs)
 5. Government departments and private organizations should also be allowed to import staff transport vehicles special designed or having accessibility for the PWDs.
 6. The Commerce Ministry should also consider PWDs in their new schemes or shall introduce special schemes for the PWDs.
 7. PWDs should also be included in the upcoming e-commerce policy.
 8. Ministry to apprise about the PWDs related special concessions currently offered.
 9. Ministry of Commerce to recommend FBR for the incorporation more items into Pakistan Customs Tariff (PCT) Code 9937, so the PWDs are maximum benefited; and
 10. Any other Item with the permission of the Chair.
