ANNOUNCEMENT

Mr. Speaker announced that today the members of the National Assembly will elect their Speaker and Deputy Speaker. There are two validly nominated members for the election of Speaker. So, the member who will secure more votes than the other will be declared to have been elected as Speaker. Mr. Speaker read out the names of the members who have been duly nominated alongwith the names of their proposers:-

- The honourable members were informed that the members may withdraw their candidature at any time before the Assembly proceeds to elect a Speaker.
- The honourable members were also informed that since there is no provision in the Rules of Procedure for fixation of time of election, therefore the voting will be closed, when the presiding officer is satisfied that all the members present have voted.

PROCEDURE FOR ELECTION OF THE SPEAKER

For convenience of the honorable members, Mr. Speaker read out the procedure to be adopted for the conduct of election of Speaker.

- 1. The election will be by secret ballot.
- 2. Each member has one vote.
- 3. In order to cast their votes the names of the members in Urdu alphabetical order will be called out by the Secretary, National Assembly one by one.
- 4. Before delivering the ballot paper to a member, it will be signed by an officer of the National Assembly Secretariat and stamped on its reverse with the seal of the Assembly.
- 5. The member will then proceed to the enclosure near the table of the Presiding Officer and put a cross mark (X) with stamp on the ballot paper against the name of the candidate of his choice.
- 6. If the cross mark stamp is not marked properly the vote shall be considered as invalid vote and shall not be counted in favour of any candidate.
- 7. The ballot paper will be folded before it is inserted in the ballot box placed on my left side.
- 8. If any ballot paper is inadvertently spoiled by a member, he may ask for the fresh one after returning the spoiled ballot paper which would be cancelled.
- 9. One Polling Agent may be nominated by each candidate.
- 10. After all the members have voted, the presiding officer will announce the closure of voting and direct the Secretary to open the ballot box in the presence of polling agents, count all the ballot papers and submit its result to the Presiding Officer.
- 11. The Presiding Officer will announce the result and declare the member who have been elected as Speaker
