### INTRODUCTION OF BILL

“(6) In relation to each Ministry's annual budgetary proposals comprising of demands for grants and appropriations and development expenditure for the next fiscal year, -

- (a) each Ministry shall submit its annual budgetary proposals for the next fiscal year to the concerned Standing Committee not later than the 30<sup>th</sup> January;
- (b) the Standing Committee concerned shall scrutinize the proposals and recommend to the National Assembly amendments therein, not later than the 20<sup>th</sup> February, if necessary, provided that if the recommendations are not made by any concerned Standing Committee by the 20<sup>th</sup> February, such budgetary proposals may be forwarded to the National Assembly for consideration; and
- (c) the National Assembly shall finalize the recommendations in a pre-budget session not later than the 5<sup>th</sup> March and such recommendations may be incorporated by the concerned Ministry in its budgetary proposals for next fiscal year.”

10. **MS. ANUSHA REHMAN KHAN ADVOCATE**, to move that the proposed amendments in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, be adopted.
