ANNOUNCEMENT REGARDING ELECTION OF THE SPEAKER AND DEPUTY SPEAKER

Mr. Speaker informed the House that as announced earlier the election of the Speaker and the Deputy Speaker will be held on **1st March, 2024**. For convenience of the honourable members, Mr. Speaker read out the procedure for the election of the Speaker and the Deputy Speaker as provided in rules 9 and 10 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007. The honourable Members who want to contest the election, will deliver the nomination papers to the Secretary, National Assembly Secretariat, at any time before 12:00 noon today the **29th February, 2024**. Nomination papers are to be signed by the proposer and accompanied by a statement by the candidate that he is willing to serve as Speaker/Deputy

Speaker of the National Assembly of Pakistan, if elected. The nomination papers can be obtained from the Secretariat, but they have already submitted. On the day of election, the names of duly nominated candidates and also the names of their proposers will be read out to the Assembly and;

- If there is only one candidate, he shall be declared elected.
- If there are only two candidates, election would be held through a secret ballot and the candidate who secures more votes than the other, shall be declared to have been elected.
- However, in case of equal number of votes, a fresh ballot shall be held until one of them secures more votes than the other. In case of more than two candidates the candidate obtaining more votes than the aggregate of the votes secured by the other candidates shall be declared to have been elected. If no candidate secures more votes than the aggregate votes secured by the other candidates, there shall be a fresh ballot and the candidate who secures the lowest votes shall be excluded. In case of three or more candidates securing an equal number of votes for exclusion of one of such candidates, lots will be drawn. The member elected as Speaker and Deputy Speaker shall make an oath before the Assembly in the form set out in the Third Schedule to the Constitution before entering upon the office.
- The election will be by secret ballot.
- The same procedure will be followed for the election of Deputy Speaker
