MOTION

Ms. Shazia Marri, MNA moved the following motion which was adopted by the House:-
“that under rule 288 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, that the requirement of rule 290 of the said Rules be dispensed with in order to allow the use of Chamber of the National Assembly on 2nd April, 2024 or on the day as may be announced for Election to fill the seats in the Senate from the Federal Capital.”

MOTION

Ms. Shazia Marri, MNA moved the following motion, which was adopted by the House:-
“that under rule 288 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, requirements of rules 51, 55, 57 and 158 of the said Rules in respect of ballot of Private Members’ Resolutions, Orders of the day and notice of Resolution for today may be suspended in order to take up the resolutions.”

RESOLUTION

Ms. Shazia Marri, MNA moved the following motion, which was unanimously adopted by the House:-
“This House recognizes that the trial and subsequent conviction of Shaheed Prime Minister Zulfikar Ali Bhutto was a gross miscarriage of justice;
Salutes the struggles of Begum Nustrat Bhutto Sahiba, Shaheed Mohtarma Benazir Bhutto, and the Pakistan Peoples Party workers who sacrificed their lives to establish this truth;
Appreciates the determination with which President Asif Ali Zardari filed presidential reference to reopen the case 12 years ago and Bilawal Bhutto Zardari who single mindedly pursued it;
Lauds the honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan for finally holding and accepting the glaring injustice meted out to Shaheed Bhutto 44 years ago, in its judgment;
The proceedings of the trial by the Lahore High Court and of the appeal by the Supreme Court of Pakistan do not meet the requirements of the Fundamental Right to a fair trial and due process enshrined in Articles 4 and 9 of the Constitution and later guaranteed as a separate and independent Fundamental Right under Article 10A of the Constitution;”
Demands that in light of this historic judgment, the unjust verdict given in Shaheed Zulfikar Ali Bhutto case must be overturned;
Further demands that the Federal Government officially declare Prime Minister Zulfikar Ali Bhutto as a “Shaheed” and “National Democratic Hero,” and confers upon him the highest Civil Award which is the “Nishan-e-Pakistan”. And further demands the establishment of the “Nishan-e-Zulfikar Ali Bhutto” award for workers and activists who have fought and sacrificed their lives for true democracy in Pakistan.”
