FATEHA

The House offered “**Fateha**” for the departed souls of the following:-

- i) Three policemen including a DSP martyred in a mine blast in Lakki Marwat, KPK on 30th March, 2024;
- ii) Seventeen peoples died and more than fifty people injured, in a truck accident on 11th April, 2024 in Hub, Balochistan;
- iii) Eleven passengers martyred in a terrorists attack in Nushki, Balochistan on 13th April, 2024;
- iv) Two soldiers martyred in an encounter with terrorists in District Buner, KPK on 13th April, 2024;
- v) Mr. Javed Ibrahim Prahcha, former member National Assembly;
- vi) At least sixty four citizens martyred in street crimes in Karachi, during last three months;
- vii) Several people died due to recent heavy rains in the country;
- viii) People died in different incidents in the country;
- ix) Brother of Mr. Muhammad Aamir Doger, Member National Assembly;
- x) Three Pakistani martyred in Malaysia, who were hit by a car when they were on the way to perform Eid prayers; and
- xi) The House also prayed for recovery of policemen injured in Bahawalnagar.
