MOTION OF SUSPENSION OF MEMEBRS

Mr. Speaker put the following question to the House, which was adopted by the House:-

“that during the address of the President to both Houses assembled together on 18th April, 2024, Jamshaid Ahmed Dasti and Muhammad Iqbal Khan, MNAs used abusive language, approached the dais of the Speaker in threatening manner that should have not been approached, blowing whistles and trumpets which have never been blown in the Parliament, chanted objectionable slogans, displayed banners and placards, indulged in rowdy behavior like unbecoming of a Parliamentarian thereby eroded sanctity of the House, in sheer violation of rule 30 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, thereby disregarding the authority of Speaker and abusing the Rules by consistently and willfully disrupting and obstructing the proceedings. I, therefore, name them in terms of rule 21 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, read with rule 33 of the Parliament (Joint Sittings) Rules, 1973. Jamshaid Ahmed Dasti, MNA and Muhammad Iqbal Khan, MNA be suspended from the service of the Assembly for the remainder of the session.

These Members shall now forthwith withdraw from the precincts of the Assembly under rule 21 Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007,
