## REPORT OF THE STANDING COMMITTEE ON LAW AND JUSTICE ON THE POINT OF ORDER, REGARDING RECENT JUDGMENT OF THE HON. SUPREME COURT OF PAKISTAN IN CASE TITLED AS, THE STATE VS. MUBARAK AHMAD SANI AND ANOTHER.

1, Chairman of the Standing Committee on Law and Justice, have the honour to present this report on the point of order, regarding Judgment dated 24<sup>th</sup> July, 2024 of the Hon. Supreme Court of Pakistan in case titled "The State vs. Mubarak Ahmad Sani and another", referred to the Standing Committee on 30<sup>th</sup> July 2024.

The meetings were attended by, Sahibzada Muhammad Hamid Raza, MNA Moulana Abdul Ghafoor Haideri, MNA, Ms. Ayesha Nazir, MNA Mr. Muhammad Usman Badini, MNA, Mr. Shafqat Abbas, MNA, Mr. Muhammad Jamal Ahsan Khan, MNA, Mr. Muhammad Hanif Abbasi MNA, and Mr. Abdul Qadir Patel MNA, as movers/Special Invitee and volunteers. In addition, on the request of one of the Movers, complainant of the case FIR was also allowed to brief the Committee in-person.

4. The Committee considered the Point of Order as referred to it by the National Assembly vide at Annex-A, in its meetings held on 31<sup>st</sup> July 2024 (for almost 5 hours) and 15<sup>th</sup> August 2024 (for almost 4 hours). Keeping in view the sensitivity of the matter, the Committee held all the proceedings in-camera. During detailed deliberations, it was unanimously decided by the Committee that National Assembly shall pass a resolution directing the Federal Government to file appropriate application/initiate proceedings in the Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan for setting the law right, as legal and factual errors have been found in the decision. Some of the members were also of the view to file a reference against all members of the bench. However, Members of the Committee were not unanimous on this issue and therefore, the Committee decided to send a unanimous recommendation to the National Assembly.

5. In view of above, the Committee unanimously recommended to the National Assembly to pass a resolution, directing the Federal Government to file appropriate application/initiate proceedings regarding the order of Honourable Supreme Court of Pakistan for setting the law right.
