Resolves to take every possible measure to eliminate terrorism from every corner of our nation and affirms that no group, no individual and no ideology that seeks to undermine our nation’s peace, prosperity and sovereignty will be allowed to spread fear, hatred and violence within the territorial limits of the country. Furthermore, pledges, not to allow any terrorist activity to go unchecked in any part of our country and commits to working relentlessly to root out terrorism in all its forms and manifestations, ensuring that those who attempt to destabilize the country face the full force of the law.

This House expresses our deepest respect and gratitude to the brave men and women who have sacrificed their lives in these tragic incidents, recognizing their courage, sacrifice and patriotism.

This House extends sincere appreciation to the Pakistan Army, Air Force, SSG and other law enforcing agencies for their unwavering commitment, bravery and sacrifice in safeguarding the lives of the citizens and protecting the integrity of Pakistan. Their heroic efforts in neutralizing the terrorists involved in this incident reflect the resolve and readiness of our security forces to defend our nation at all costs.

This House calls upon the people of Pakistan, regardless of ethnicity, religion or background, to unite in the fight against terrorism and to reject extremism in all its forms, ensuring the peace, safety and prosperity of our nation for future generations.”
