## RESOLUTION

Syed Naveed Qamar, MNA, moved the following resolution, which was unanimously adopted by the House:-

“The National Assembly of Pakistan strongly condemns the unjustified and illegitimate aggression by Israel against the brotherly Islamic Republic of Iran, causing grave loss of lives and property to the Iranian People.

This House notes with utter disgust and dismay that the strikes carried in the dark hours of June 13, 2025 is not only a serious violation of the sovereignty and integrity of United Nations Member state, but it also clearly contravenes the fundamental principles of international law and the United Nations Charter;

This House warns that such continued blatant acts of aggression by Israel have brought not only the Middle East but the entire world into serious dangers, the consequence of which shall entirely rest on Israel. Iran has a right to self-defense under Article 51 of the UN Charter.

This House reiterates that Pakistan stands in complete solidarity with the Government, Parliament and the people of the Islamic Republic of Iran and prays for those who lost their lives in this attack;

This House further calls upon Government to immediately call for a meeting of the OIC as well as of the Security Council not only to discuss but to condemn this aggression and bring an immediate stop to it.”
