(Change in Schedule)

In continuation of this Secretariat's Notice of even number dated 5<sup>th</sup> September, 2025, it is hereby informed that the 6<sup>th</sup> meeting of the Standing Committee on **Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development** schedule for 17<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 will now be held on **Thursday, the 18<sup>th</sup> September, 2025 at 11:00 a.m. in Constitution Room (old Committee Room No. 5), Second Floor, Parliament House, Islamabad.** The agenda will however remain the same as detailed below:-

      - Benefits and legal safeguards provided to protected workers;
      - Nature and volume of pending claims, including compensation and repatriation cases;
    - iv) Monitoring and regulation of Overseas Employment Promoters (OEPs):-
      - Licensing, blacklisting criteria, and enforcement against violators;
      - Public grievances, complaint redressal system, and statistics on excessive fee charging or contract violations;
      - Measures to protect migrant workers from fraud, trafficking, and exploitation;
    - v) BEOE's operational oversight, including pre-departure orientation and emigration clearance processes;
    - vi) Status of compliance on recommendations previously issued by the Committee specifically to the Bureau regarding structural reforms, worker welfare, data transparency, and inter-agency coordination;
  - 5) Discussion on the critical issue of Pakistani citizens trapped in Cambodia, including:-
    - i) The status of their repatriation efforts;
    - ii) Diplomatic coordination;
    - iii) Responsibility of recruiting agents or traffickers involved;
    - iv) Policy and legislative gap enabling such trafficking rings to operate; and
  - 6) Any other item with permission of the Chair.
