

 - Mechanisms ensuring transparency, merit-based selection, gender balance, and representation from federal and provincial departments.
 - iv) **Monitoring and Evaluation:**
 - Framework for assessing program effectiveness and outcomes in terms of skill enhancement and institutional performance.
 - Post-training monitoring and utilization of trained officers in relevant government functions.
