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The National Assembly of Pakistan met in the National Assembly Hall (Parliament House) Islamabad, at 11:20 a.m. with the honourable Speaker (Sardar Ayaz Sadiq) in the Chair.

### APPOINTMENTS MADE IN ASSOCIATED PRESS OF PAKISTAN CORPORATION

#### 6. \*Mr. Muhammad Riaz Fatyana:

*Will the Minister for Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state:*

- (a) *whether the appointments made in the Associated Press of Pakistan Corporation (APPC) since 2023 were advertised publicly in accordance with the APPC Service Rules, 2004 and the Government Servants Rules;*
- (b) *whether prior financial sanction or approval was obtained from the Finance Division or from the Ministry;*
- (c) *if not, how the salaries and benefits of such appointees were processed;*
- (d) *whether any inquiry has been conducted into the financial burden on the national exchequer;*
- (e) *whether these appointments adhered to the Constitutional quota system for provinces, women, minorities and persons with disabilities; and*
- (f) *whether the Ministry has examined the Auditor General of Pakistan's report indicating irregular appointments, backdated payments and hiring of over aged individuals, causing loss to the National exchequer?*

**Minister for Information and Broadcasting (Mr. Attaullah Tarar):**

- (a)• The appointments made since 2023 were carried out under the full appointment powers delegated to the Managing Director by the Board of Directors in its 5th meeting (**Annex-I**). In exercise of these powers, and to prevent technical disruption of equipment worth more than a billion rupees by ensuring its operability through trained personnel, some individuals engaged after 2023, former PSDP project staff, were reappointed through test and interview on considerably lower pay scales and strictly within sanctioned posts and budget. Part-time correspondents in remote areas were engaged solely on an honorary, non-remunerated basis. No employee has been regularized during the period in question. The appointments in question therefore fall squarely within established practice and remain fully aligned with the procedural framework consistently followed by all previous Managing Directors.
- (b)• The appointments were made strictly within the sanctioned strength and approved budget of the Corporation. These appointments were fully aligned with or within the budgetary provisions granted to APPC.
- (c)• The salaries and admissible fringe benefits of these employees were, thus, processed from approved budgetary allocations, and within the approved strength. The Corporation did not seek or utilize any additional funds beyond the sanctioned limit. All payments were made in accordance with government financial rules, ensuring complete compliance and fiscal discipline.
- (d)• No financial burden has, at any stage, been placed upon the national exchequer or the Corporation. The appointments were made within the approved cadre and budgetary ceiling, and did not entail any additional liability. On the contrary, by utilizing trained project staff at lower pay scales, the Corporation achieved cost efficiency and operational continuity without compromising financial prudence.

- (e)• APPC management has ensured strict compliance with quota requirements. However, the overall workforce composition of APPC reflects a slight imbalance in the observance of quotas, as shown in **(Annex-II)** This imbalance did not arise from routine recruitment practices but resulted primarily from large scale regularization and reinstatement of employees pursuant to decisions of competent forums, including the Cabinet Committee headed by Mr. Khursheed Shah (342 employees), the Special Committee of the National Assembly chaired by Mr. Qadir Khan Mandokhel (135 employees), and the Prime Minister's Assistance Package (33 employees).
  - In consequence of these decisions, more than 500 employees were absorbed into service through one-time measures, which were binding on the organization and implemented in compliance with directions of the competent authorities. These regularizations, being exceptional in nature and not processed through the standard recruitment framework, inadvertently affected the proportional observance of prescribed quotas. The resultant imbalance, therefore, cannot be attributed to any willful disregard of constitutional or statutory requirements by APPC management.
- (f)• The Auditor General of Pakistan (AGP) has pointed out financial irregularities with respect to APPC Employees Related Expenses (ERE) and Provident Fund (PF), including the transfer of funds to other APPC accounts and to individuals employees accounts. The reports have also highlighted irregularities in the utilization of PSDP funds, as well as the presence of 20 fake appointments in the corporation and the disbursement of salaries to such individuals. These matters of financial irregularities are currently under investigation.
  - Regarding the irregularities in Provident Fund (PF) and Employees related Expenses (ERE), the Managing Director (MD), APPC, constituted a Fact-Finding Committee (FFC). The committee confirmed the embezzlement and recommended action against the employees involved. Subsequently, the case was referred to the Federal Investigation Agency (FIA), which has lodged an FIR and is investigating the APP officials involved, in addition to initiating recovery proceedings **(Flag-A)**. Action under the Efficiency and Discipline (E&D) Rules, 2020 has been initiated against the individuals involved.
  - With respect to irregularities observed in the utilization of PSDP funds, the report of the Fact-Finding Committee has been shared with the FIA for further investigation **(Flag-B)**. In case of fake appointments, the matter has also been referred to the FIA, which has registered a FIR and is currently conducting an inquiry **(Flag-C)**.

جناب سپیکر: انہوں نے وہ illegal کر دی ہے۔ Minister for Parliamentary Affairs

جناب طارق فضل چوہدری: بہت شکریہ۔ سر! جو جواب وزارت کی طرف سے موصول ہوا ہے وہ یقیناً ایک ذمہ دارانہ ہے اور اس میں حقائق بیان کئے گئے ہیں، اب اُن facts کو honourable Member deny کر رہے ہیں۔ سر! گزارش ہے کہ یہ جن appoint-ments کی بات کر رہے ہیں، the Powers of Managing Director which were given by the Board، of Directors in his fifth meeting annexure کے ساتھ لگایا گیا ہے یہ بھرتیاں اُن powers کو exercise کر کے ہوئی ہیں۔ گزارش یہ ہے کہ مختلف محکموں میں بھرتیوں کا اپنا ایک طریقہ کار ہے۔ سب سے پہلی بات تو ہے کہ یہ regular بھرتیاں نہیں ہیں جو اس وقت زیر بحث ہیں۔ یہ contractual تھے اور جو Board of Directors نے Managing Director کو powers delegate کی تھیں اُس کے تحت ان کا باقاعدہ ٹیسٹ وائر ویو ہوا اور میرٹ پر یہ بھرتیاں ہوئیں۔ Managing Director کو جو mandate دیا گیا ہے اُس کے تحت یہ ساری بھرتیاں ہوئی ہیں۔ دوسری بات یہ ہے کہ جو ان کی sanction strength تھی اُس کے تحت اور اُس کے اندر یہ بھرتیاں ہوئی ہیں، اُس سے باہر نہیں ہوئیں۔ تیسری بات یہ ہے کہ اس میں جو پوچھا گیا کہ salaries سے قومی خزانے پر کوئی بوجھ وغیرہ پڑا تو بالکل نہیں پڑا کیونکہ یہ approved budget allocations تھیں۔ چوتھی بات یہ ہے کہ اس میں provincial quota کو سو فیصد follow کیا گیا ہے۔ میں honourable Member سے یہ گزارش کروں گا کہ اگر ان کے علم میں کوئی ایسی معلومات

ہیں جو دیئے گئے جواب سے متضاد ہیں تو وہ مجھ سے share کریں، میں اس بات کیلئے بالکل تیار ہوں کہ جو ہماری relevant authorities اُن سے بات کر کے میں ہاؤس کو دوبارہ update کروں گا اور ممبر کو بھی اس پر satisfy کروں گا۔

جناب سپیکر: فتیانہ صاحب آپ اگر satisfy نہیں ہیں جو انہوں نے بات کی تو آپ ہمیں وہ points لکھ کر دیجئے جو آپ نے ابھی raise کئے ہیں۔ So we can take up that later on۔ فتیانہ صاحب کا mic کھولیں۔

جناب سپیکر: ٹھیک ہے لیکن آپ کا سوال کیا ہے؟

سید رفیع اللہ: سر! سوال یہ ہے کہ میں ان کی اس بات کی تائید کر رہا ہوں، خاص طور پر کوٹے پر میں پہلے بھی کئی دفعہ کہہ چکا ہوں کہ بلوچستان، سندھ، پنجاب اور خیبر پختونخوا، چاروں صوبوں میں کوٹے کا جو ایشو ہے وہ صحیح ہے لیکن یہ آج سے نہیں ہے، پچھلے دور میں انہوں نے اسی طرح کیا تھا اور آج بھی یہ ہو رہا ہے۔

## **PAKISTAN LAUNCHED HYPER SPECTRAL SATELLITE HS-I**

### **29. \*Syeda Amnah Batool:**

*Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether the Government has prepared a national framework for the civilian, agricultural, environmental and disaster-management use of Pakistan's newly launched hyperspectral Satellite HS-I;*
- (b) if so, the departments to be integrated with satellite data and expected benefits thereof;*
- (c) if not, the reasons for non-finalization of utilization plan despite successful launch?*

**Minister for Defence (Khawaja Muhammad Asif):** (a) Pakistan launched its first Hyper-Spectral Satellite (HS-I) on October 19, 2025. The HS-I satellite is currently undergoing in Orbit Testing (IOD) phase with image data expected to be available to user organizations by end of Jan 2026. A comprehensive national utilization framework for civilian applications in agriculture, environment, and disaster management is under progressive implementation, under which SUPARCO coordinates with key Federal and provincial departments for integration of satellite data, capacity building and general awareness.

A fully finalized, standalone utilization plan is evolving amid the ongoing in-orbit testing phases of the satellite, phased onboarding of the user departments, and the need for capacity building and institutional readiness. Meanwhile, SUPARCO is operationalizing satellite data use through framework MoUs, service-based agreements and engagements, disaster watch platforms digital satellite service portals, and structured training programs, each including dedicated components for HS-I Satellite.

(b) The ability of hyper-spectral imaging provides detailed spectral information in more than hundred continuous spectral bands making it ideal for a wide array of applications in sector viz agriculture forestry, environment, disaster management, marine ecology, geology and mineral prospection. The expected benefits include, but not limited to:

- o Enhanced crop assessment
- o Land and forest monitoring
- o Disaster preparedness and response
- o Environmental protection
- o Mineral prospection
- o Evidence based planning, etc.

Therefore, SUPARCO is working interactively across Federal & Provincial government departments, universities, and research centers through project services, targeted trainings and framework MoUs for creating awareness, building capacity and integrating technology in every sector.

## **DETAILS OF INFORMATION LITERACY PROGRAMME**

### **44. \*Ms. Naeema Kishwer Khan:**

*Will the Minister for Information and Broadcasting be pleased to state the department-wise details of the Information Literacy Programme (ILP), working at present and its function and performance during the last two years?*

**Minister for Information and Broadcasting (Mr. Attaullah Tarar):**

- The Ministry of Information and Broadcasting, through its attached departments and subordinate organizations, carries out a range of initiatives and activities aimed at promoting information literacy, media awareness and digital literacy in line with their respective mandates. These efforts contribute to the broader objectives of public awareness and responsible media engagement, however, they are not undertaken under any formally titled programme known as the “Information Literacy Programme (ILP).
- Pakistan Television Corporation (PTVC) contributes to information literacy through educational and awareness-oriented programming, while the PTV Drama & Film Academy conducts capacity-building initiatives for media professionals on digital literacy, artificial intelligence (AI), ethical journalism, credible news production, and public awareness content. Details are provided in **Annex-A**.
- Pakistan Broadcasting Corporation (PBC), through Radio Pakistan, plays a pivotal role in promoting media and information literacy nationwide, particularly in remote and underserved areas. Through its Programme Wing and News & Current Affairs Channel, PBC integrates themes of responsible information use, digital awareness, and countering misinformation into a wide range of programmes in 23 languages, including educational, youth, women, religious, and current affairs content. Details are provided in **Annex-B**.
- The Press Information Department (PID) promotes responsible information consumption through print, electronic, and digital media campaigns. Its Countering Violent Extremism (CVE) Cell conducts seminars, training sessions, and outreach activities for journalists, students, and civil society. In addition, large-scale communication campaigns addressing fake news, cybersecurity, national security, Kashmir, economy, and youth empowerment have generated extensive public outreach and awareness over the last two years. Details are provided in **Annex-C**.
- The Press Council of Pakistan (PCP) supports media literacy through internship programmes and seminars, organized in collaboration with universities, UNESCO, and other stakeholders, with a focus on ethical journalism and combating fake news. Details are provided in **Annex-D**.
- The Information Service Academy (ISA) contributes through specialized training programmes, mid-career courses, AI workshops, seminars, and academic outreach activities. These initiatives embed information and media literacy, ethics, and digital communication skills within its structured curricula during 2024–2025. Details are provided in **Annex-E**.
- The Associated Press of Pakistan (APP) advances media and information literacy by ensuring accurate and ethical news dissemination, conducting regular training on fake news, AI in journalism, and media ethics. Details are provided in **Annex-F**.
- Overall, during the last two years, the collective efforts of the Ministry’s departments have effectively advanced information literacy, responsible media practices, and public awareness across Pakistan.

*Will the Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination be pleased to state the details of the grants given to the Federal Sports Federations and their activities to promote sports in the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (KP) and particularly in District Lakki Marwat during the last three years?*

**Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination:** Details of grants disbursed by Pakistan Sports Board to sports organizations during the last three years are as under which also include an amount of Rs. 0.80 million paid to District Football Association, Laki Marwat during the Financial Year 2022-23:

1. 2022-23 - 422.293 million
2. 2023-24 - 509.133 million
3. 2024-25 - Rs. 101.996 million

National Sports Federations (NSFs) are affiliated with PSB to regulate their respective sports at the national level. These Federations are recognized on a national basis, irrespective of province, and are responsible for selection of players & teams, conducting national championships and arranging participation in international sports events. The selection of venues for championships and events is decided by the concerned Federation.

The National Sports Federations have their Provincial and District Associations; which are affiliated with the respective Provincial Sports Boards/Directorates and do not fall directly under the administrative domain of PSB. District Lakki Marwat falls within the jurisdiction of the Khyber Pakhtunkhwa Sports Directorate, under the Provincial Government of Khyber Pakhtunkhwa.

## **PASSENGERS FACILITIES AT QUETTA INTERNATIONAL AIRPORT**

### **31. \*Nawabzada Mir Jamal Khan Raisani:**

*Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state whether modern security screening and passenger facilitation systems will be installed at Quetta International Airport to improve operational efficiency?*

**Minister for Defence (Khawaja Muhammad Asif):** The Quetta International Airport has implemented the latest security protocols in line with International Standards to ensure the safety of passengers and staff. The installation of the latest scanning machines along with modern security equipment is near to finalization. After this modern installation, the security measures will effectively meet the regional security situation. Furthermore, a joint security team from the Pakistan Civil Aviation Authority (PCAA) and Pakistan Airports Authority recently visited the airport to review and enhance security measures.

As regards Passenger facilities at Quetta International Airport is concerned, which are provided as per International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) Standards. These include, among others, meet-and-greet services, dedicated seating areas, drinking water, washrooms, free Wi-Fi, and luggage trolleys. The airport is undergoing continuous enhancement of facilities to further improve passenger experience and comply with the latest international standards.

## **RESTORE FLIGHT OPERATIONS FOR BALOCHISTAN**

### **42. \*Nawabzada Mir Jamal Khan Raisani:**

*Will the Minister for Defence be pleased to state whether the Government has any plan to restore or expand flight operations for Balochistan?*

**Minister for Defence (Khawaja Muhammad Asif):** There are currently seven (07) operational airports in Balochistan region which are as follows:

1. Quetta Int'l Airport.
2. Zhob Airport.
3. Pasni Airport.
4. Panjgur Airport.
5. Turbat Int'l Airport.
6. Dalbandin Airport.
7. New Gawadar Int'l Airport.

These airports are operational and available for flight operations.

## **GREEN AREAS REOCCUPIED BY HOSTELS ON ISLAMABAD CLUB ROAD, ISLAMABAD**

### **30. \*Mr. Sher Afzal Khan:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

*(a) whether it is a fact that the green areas have been re-occupied/encroached by the Hotels on the Islamabad Club Road, Islamabad;*

*(b) if so, the reasons for not taking any action so far?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) It is hereby submitted that total 10 Hotels/Motels are located at Islamabad Club Road/Murree Road. They have developed illegal parking which is on green area of Right of way of this road. These Illegal parking / encroachment areas were demolished with the help of Enforcement Directorate, CDA on 06-08-2024. Challans for construction of illegal parking/encroachment area have also been filed in the Court of Senior Special Magistrate, CDA for proceeding against all these hotels / Motels as per relevant rules.

(b) Repeated action is being taken frequently, to physically remove these encroachments. Legal proceedings have also been initiated which are pending before the Senior Special Magistrate, CDA.

## **NEW PROGRAMMES INTRODUCED FOR OVERSEAS PAKISTANIS**

31. **\*Ms. Asiya Naz Tanoli:**

*Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the details of new programmes which have been introduced for Overseas Pakistanis in recent years; and*
- (b) *the steps being taken by the Government to facilitate and support the workers/investors and skilled individuals under these programmes?*

**Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development (Chaudhary Salik Hussain):** (a) A number of initiatives have been taken by the Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis & Human Resource Development, through OPF, to safeguard the rights and welfare of overseas Pakistanis. Various incentives and facilities are being provided both to Pakistanis abroad and to their dependents in Pakistan. The existing schemes are continuously revised and upgraded to ensure efficient service delivery for the benefit of overseas Pakistanis and their families. Details of existing schemes and facilities are as follows:

**Welfare Schemes for Overseas Pakistanis:**

- 1) **Financial assistance** to the destitute families of overseas Pakistanis in the event of death or disability of an overseas Pakistani amounting to Rs. 400,000/- and Rs. 300,000/-, respectively, amount Disbursed **Rs. 712/-million**, No of Beneficiaries: 1710
- 2) **Free ambulance service** for transportation of human remains and critically ill Pakistanis from international airports in Pakistan to their native town/village, ambulance provided: 302
- 3) **Funeral Grant** of Rs.25,000/- for the needy and destitute families of deceased overseas Pakistanis (who died abroad) to bury their loved ones with dignity, funeral Grant Cases: 49, amount Disbursed: **Rs 12,25,000/-**
- 4) **Recovery of outstanding end of service benefits/dues** of repatriated and expired Pakistani workers from employers abroad, amount Disbursed: **Rs.597.41/- million**, number of Beneficiaries: 256
- 5) **OPF Online Complaint Management System (OCMS)** and linkage with Pakistan Citizens Portal (PCP) of Prime Minister Delivery Unit (PMDU) for speedy resolution of complaints, complaints Received: **6,338**, complaints Resolved: **3,905**
- 6) **24/7 Complaint Monitoring Cell (Helpline)** established in OPF Head Office for providing all possible assistance to overseas Pakistanis in terms of their complaints and its resolutions. Total calls/WhatsApp messages received **7,225**.
- 7) **One Window Facilitation Desks (OWFDs)**
  - i) In order to assist the overseas Pakistanis, OPF has established airport counters at all International Airports in Pakistan. Airport facilitation counters are functioning in the Arrival/departure lounges of Islamabad airports. Karachi, Lahore, Quetta, Peshawar, Multan, Sialkot, Faisalabad, Turbat and Gwadar. Necessary assistance is provided to overseas Pakistanis at the time of arrival and departure. Total **8635** complaints/issues received and resolved at One Window Facilitation Desks (OWFDs) at all International Airport in Pakistan.
  - ii) Under the Assisted Reintegration and Development (ARD) Projects (ICMPD&GIZ) facilitation desks established at Islamabad, Peshawar, and Lahore International Airports. Voluntary data collection from returnee migrants is being conducted to assess their reintegration needs, and data of around 1100 individuals has been collected to date.

- 8) **One Window Facilitation – NADRA and Passport Office** at OPF Head Office, Islamabad for issuance of NICOP, POC and Machine-Readable Passports (MRPs).
- 9) **Facilitation Desk** for overseas Pakistanis at Islamabad Police Citizen Service Center, Islamabad.
- 10) **NH&MP Facilitation Centre** at Driving Licensing Authority (DLA), H-8/2, Islamabad for issuance of international Driving licenses to overseas Pakistanis.
- 11) **Pakistan-German Facilitation & Reintegration Centre (PGFRC)** at Lahore and an Advisory Desk in Islamabad to cater to reintegration needs of returnee Pakistanis from abroad.
- 12) **Emergency Relief activities** to deal with crisis / unforeseen circumstances or evacuation/repatriation of Pakistanis from host countries.
- 13) **Special Court:** In order to provide an immediate relief to Overseas Pakistanis regarding their property related problems on fast track basis, Special Court (Overseas Pakistani Property) Act, 2023 was promulgated on October 28, 2024 for resolution of property dispute cases of overseas Pakistanis at Islamabad (ICT). The same have been established by Islamabad High Court. Similarly, the Punjab Establishment of Special Courts (Overseas Pakistanis Property) Act, 2025 has been enacted by the Provincial Assembly of Punjab. The Act is aimed at protecting the immovable property rights of Overseas Pakistanis through establishment of dedicated special courts across Punjab and Hon'ble Judges has been nominated at district level. Similar to Punjab and Islamabad, the Balochistan Establishment of Special Courts (Overseas Pakistani Property) Bill has been enacted by Provincial Assembly of Balochistan, through which Special Courts for Overseas Pakistani Commission will be established to exclusively and expeditiously adjudicate their property related disputes.
- 14) **The first Annual Overseas Pakistanis Convention 2025:** First Annual Overseas Pakistanis Convention, 2025 was successfully held from 13<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 to 15<sup>th</sup> April, 2025 with active participation from stake holders, dignitaries and 1200 plus member of the overseas community across the globe. The event marked a significant milestone in fostering meaningful engagement and strengthening ties with our diaspora. During convention, the Honorable Prime Minister of Pakistan announced incentives and policy reforms aimed at facilitating diaspora investment, easing processes and recognizing the vital role of overseas Pakistanis in national development.
- 15) **MOU with NAB:** OPF signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the National Accountability Bureau (NAB) on January 30, 2025 to establish a collaborative framework aimed at addressing issues faced by overseas Pakistanis. The primary objective of this collaboration is to establish a structured framework for communication and collaboration between OPF & NAB to expedite cases and to maintain a centralized record of all complaints forward by OPF, tracking their progress and resolution status.
- 16) **MOU with Pakistan Employees Association, Hungary:** OPF signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Pakistan Employees Association in Hungary on 05.08.2025. The agreement aims to promote legal employment, ensure residence and visa facilitation, safeguard the rights of Pakistani workers, and support their voluntary and dignified return upon expiry of employment or permits.

- 17) **MOU with Anti-Corruption Establishment (ACE) Punjab:** On 17 May 2025, OPF signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with ACE Punjab to safeguard overseas Pakistanis against land grabbing, property record manipulation, and departmental mismanagement through dedicated facilitation desks and focal persons, ensuring transparency and swift complaint resolution.
- 18) **MOU with Crime Control Department (CCD) Punjab:** On 17 May 2025, OPF signed Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with CCD Punjab to address overseas Pakistanis' grievances, including property disputes, financial fraud, and misuse of authority. Dedicated facilitation desks and focal persons have been established to ensure transparency, accountability, and timely redressal of complaints.
- 19) **Civil Awards for Overseas Pakistanis:** In line with the Prime Minister's directive during the Overseas Pakistanis Convention 2025, eminent overseas Pakistanis worldwide are now nominated annually for civil awards in recognition of their services. 16 eminent overseas Pakistanis have been nominated for civil awards in various categories on 14th August, 2025. These will be conferred during the Pakistan Day Ceremony in March 2026.
- 20) **New Incentive Package for Overseas Pakistanis:** A comprehensive package of exclusive incentives has been launched for overseas Pakistanis and their families, including Next-Generation Membership Card (physical and virtual) with advanced security features.
- 21) **Discount Program for Overseas Pakistanis and Their Families:** A nationwide discount program has been introduced in Collaboration with leading private sector companies. This program enables OPF members and their families to avail preferential rates in healthcare, pharmaceuticals, retail, hospitality, and diagnostic services.
- 22) **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) have been signed between the OPF and Islamabad Diagnostic Centre (IDC)** to facilitate the overseas Pakistanis and their families for provision of discounted healthcare services at all IDC facilities throughout Pakistan. They offered flat discount on 30% on lab and 20% on imaging for overseas Pakistanis & their dependents.
- 23) OPF signed an MoU with Metropole Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. on 05.08.2025 to extend a 25% discount on all diagnostic and pathology services to OPF members and their families across MPL's branches nationwide. This collaboration is part of OPF's National Discount Program and is aimed at enhancing healthcare access and strengthening welfare support for overseas Pakistanis and their dependents.
- 24) The Overseas Pakistanis Foundation (OPF) signed an insurance agreement with United Insurance Company of Pakistan (UIC) for accidental insurance coverage to overseas Pakistanis and their dependents. Agreement with United Insurance Company of Pakistan (UIC) for accidental insurance coverage of Rs.1Million to overseas Pakistanis and Rs.1Million for his family along with disability and repatriation of mortal remain.
- 25) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) have been signed with "Best western Premier Hotel Islamabad" on 08/10/2025.
- 26) Memorandum of Understanding (MOU)s have been signed with "Dental Solutions Islamabad" 18/11/2025.
- 27) On 5<sup>th</sup> of January 2026, an MOU was signed between Overseas Pakistanis Foundation & Hotel Hillview Islamabad under OPF's "Discount Program for Overseas Pakistanis & Their Families".
- 28) Nayab Labs & Diagnostic Centre signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the Overseas Pakistanis Foundation (OPF) in January 2026 to provide comprehensive, quality diagnostic services at discounted rates. This partnership aims to enhance healthcare access for OPF employees, overseas Pakistanis, and their families.

- (b) Various incentives and facilities are being provided, as available on the OPF website ([www.opf.org.pk](http://www.opf.org.pk)) and through social media campaigns on Facebook and Twitter, and are briefed to OPF members at the time of issuance of the OPF membership card, as well as through the Ministry of Foreign Affairs' missions abroad via Welfare Attachés. The details of welfare measures for overseas Pakistanis mentioned above also enumerate the steps being taken thereunder.

## **STEPS TAKEN TO CURB THE ILLEGAL FOREIGN CURRENCY TRADE AND SMUGGLING**

### **32. \*Shazia Marri:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) *what steps have been taken to curb the illegal foreign currency trade and smuggling; and*
- (b) *the details of the number of raids, arrests and convictions made since January, 2025?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Field offices of FIA has already been sensitized to prioritize action against illegal foreign currency operators and illegal Hawala-Hundi dealers to check illegal foreign currency trade, performance of FIA is given below.

As far as smuggling is concerned, though, primarily, it falls under the mandate of Pakistan Customs, however, FIA staff posted at Immigration check posts has already been directed to remain vigilant to counter such activity.

(b) Details of the number of raids, arrests and convictions made since January, 2025 are attached as under:

**ISSUANCE OF NOC FOR JAMMU AND KASHMIR COOPERATIVE HOUSING SOCIETY**

33. **\*Ms. Tahira Aurangzeb:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether it is a fact that the Jammu and Kashmir Cooperative Housing Society, Islamabad, applied to the Capital Development Authority (CDA) for issuance of No Objection Certificate (NOC) for Zone-IV and V and thereafter for approval of its layout plan;*
- (b) if so, the date on which such applications were submitted;*
- (c) the reasons for non-approval of the said layout plan so far;*
- (d) the plots proposed for inclusion as Farm Houses and the expected time frame for their approval; and*
- (e) the details of the officers responsible for the delay in the approval process and the action being taken against them?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Yes. The M/S J&K Housing Society has applied for Approval of Layout Plan in Zone-IV, Islamabad.

(b) On 29-05-2024, incomplete application without scrutiny fee and pre-requisite documents was submitted to CDA.

(c) The sponsors have neither deposited the Scrutiny Fee Processing Fee nor have submitted the requisite documents as per Clause 8 of Private Housing Schemes Regulations 2023 are provided. The Secretary, J&K, Housing Scheme, was advised to re-submit the required documents/layout Plan along with Scrutiny Fee and enable for proceeding further in the matter.

(d) In the first instance the Revenue Staff will scrutinize the land documents so as to identify the clear land, hence, the Project Boundary for considering the proposed LOP and proposed plots, accordingly. The LOP will be processed & approved as per SRO 866(I)/2023.

(e) There is no delay on the part of CDA. Despite repeated requests the sponsors of the scheme has still not completed the pre-requisite formalities towards processing the case for approval of LOP.

## **VIOLATIONS OF ISLAMABAD MASTER PLAN**

34. **\*Syed Rafiullah:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether the Capital Development Authority (CDA) has failed to prevent or has facilitated encroachments and un-authorized developments in violation of Islamabad's Master Plan and regulatory framework;*
- (b) whether CDA follows a cosmetic approach whereby allowing violations first and later legalizing them and undermining urban governance;*
- (c) the number of such violations that were addressed or rectified during the last year;*
- (d) how many remain and in which areas;*
- (e) the specific steps being taken to address the violations mentioned above, ensure strict enforcement and avoid further misuse of planning regulations;*
- (f) whether any fresh assessment has been undertaken to evaluate the overall impact of these violations;*
- (g) whether accountability is being fixed both on negligent CDA, officials and private violators; and*
- (h) whether a time bound action plan exists to restore compliance and prevent future infractions?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Satellite imagery-guided anti-encroachment measures have been adopted to curb illegal developments, prevent future encroachments and strengthen urban governance through technology-driven enforcement.

(b) The assertion of a cosmetic approach is incorrect. CDA has been taking action against all violations through proactive, planned and

uniform approach. Any regularization, where applicable, is strictly governed by statutory provisions and policy decisions.

(c) During the mega anti-encroachment drive conducted last year, the following violations were identified through satellite imagery and addressed by the Directorate of Enforcement, CDA: -

- **Saidpur:** Illegal structures remove from Margalla Hills National Park Area and 395 Kanals land retrieved out of 444 Kanals.
- **GT Road Tarnol (Motor Way Chowk to Nicholson monument):** Unauthorized structures removed from green belt, and R.O.W of GT Road (both Eastern & Western sides) and retrieved 474 Acres land.
- **Lehtrar Road (Barma Bridge to Bank Chowk):** Unauthorized / illegal encroachments removed (both Eastern & Western sides) and retrieved 15.75 Acres land.
- **Express way (Faizabad to Koral Chowk):** Unauthorized structures removed from green belt and Service Road (both Eastern & Western sides) an retrieved 547 Acres land.
- **GT Road (T Chowk to Rawat):** Encroachments removed from both sides (North & south) of GT Road and retrieved 21.97 Acres land.
- **Kuri Road:** Animal Barns removed from Kuri Road area and retrieved 9.96 Acres land.
- **Muslim Colony:** 2200 Households were shifted and CDA owned land measuring 729 Kanals have been retrieved from illegal constructions.

(d) Building & Housing Control Wing Reply. As regards to the violations regarding unauthorized buildings, and remaining violations within the jurisdiction of Building Control (South), it is submitted that this Directorate has already completed geo-tagged surveys in all areas of Zone-IV and Zone-V and has forwarded complete lists of illegal/unauthorized constructions to the Directorate of Enforcement for scheduling and

execution of sealing/demolition/stoppage of work operations. In this regard, necessary approvals were accorded and cases forwarded vice this office letters No.CDA/BC(S)/Sealing/Z-IV-V/2023 (765 Buildings), No.CDA/DD BC(S)/SO/ICT-Z-IV-V/2023/298 dated 09.08.2023 (597 buildings), No.CDA/DD BC(S)/SO-ICT-Z-IV/V/2023/398 dated 03.10.2023 (51 buildings), No. CDA/DD BC (S)/SP/ICT-Z-IV-V/2023/490 dated 06.12.2023 (301 buildings), and No.CDA/DD BC(S)/SO/ICT-Z-V/2023/501 dated 29.12.2023 (86) buildings), aggregating 1,800 buildings forwarded for action. The operational mechanism and execution responsibility vests with the Directorate of Enforcement as per Minutes of Meeting issued vide No.CDA/Dir (BC-S)/DVC/2023/345 dated 13.09.2023 and in this regard anti-violation operations are conducted from time to time. Similarly, regarding remaining building related violations within the jurisdiction of Building Control (North), it is submitted that this Directorate has already completed geo-tagged surveys in unplanned areas of Main GT Road Zone-II, Zone-V, Fateh Jhang Road Zone-II, Golra Revenue Estate Sector E-11 and Sector H-13, Islamabad and after issuance of Notices & Show Cause Notices sealing operations have also been conducted and as a result multiple owners/ sponsors have also started applying for regularization of the illegal / unauthorized establishments. The detail of Notices and Show Cause is as follows: -

(e) CDA has strengthened enforcement through regular anti-encroachment operations enhanced field monitoring coordination with ICT Administration and Police, use of satellite/GIS data, an strict scrutiny of building plans to ensure compliance and prevent further misuse of planning regulations.

(f) Yes, CDA has established Geo Spatial Technology Wing to assess and conduct proper surveys for evaluating the scale and impact of encroachments and unauthorized developments, with findings in order to used to refine enforcement strategies and planning controls.

(g) Accountability mechanisms are in place. Action is initiated against negligent CDA officials under applicable service rules, while private violators are proceeded against under the relevant laws, including penalties, sealing, demolition, and prosecution.

(h) A time-bound and phased action plan exists, focusing on identification, prioritization, enforcement and post-operation monitoring to restore compliance, deter further infractions, and uphold the Islamabad Master Plan and Planning Regulations.

### **ISLAMABAD FACING URBAN FLOODING**

35. **\*Mr. Anjum Aqeel Khan:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state the strategy under consideration of the Government to ensure the safety of the citizens of Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT) particularly to tackle water-related emergencies in view of the fact that Islamabad has been facing urban flooding for the last few years and several citizens have lost their lives?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** Government of Pakistan, through the Capital Emergency Service (CES) and in coordination with the Capital Development Authority (CDA), has adopted a comprehensive and multi-pronged strategy to ensure the safety of the citizens of Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT), particularly to address water-related emergencies arising from recurrent urban flooding. In this regard, the following measures have been conducted and implemented.

1. **Emergency Response and Dewatering Operations.** The Capital Emergency Service (CES), deploys trained staff, rescue teams, and dewatering units in affected and vulnerable areas. Dewatering pumps are pre-positioned at identified flood-prone locations to ensure quick removal of accumulated water from roads, underpasses, and residential areas.

2. **Life-Saving and Rescue Preparedness Training.** Fire & Rescue staff of the Capital Emergency Service have completed four-weeks (10th November 2025 to 05th December 2025) Water Rescue Training conducted by the Pakistan Navy, as well as a One-week specialized training program conducted by the Blue Sky Rescue Team from China. In addition, specialized Water Rescue Equipment (05 kits) has been donated by the Blue Sky Rescue Team, China. The teams are equipped to carry out evacuations, rescue of trapped individuals, and provide immediate emergency assistance in coordination with CDA field formations.
  
3. **Inter-Agency Coordination and Monitoring.** Coordination & Monitoring has significantly strengthened the operational capacity of CES to respond effectively to urban flooding and water rescue emergencies. Continuous coordination is maintained among CDA Directorates, Capital Emergency Service, and other relevant stakeholders ensure timely information sharing, rapid response, and effective management of water-related emergencies during heavy rains. Through the integrated preventive, preparedness, and response measures, the Capital Emergency Service, with the support of the CDA, remain-committed to minimize risks, protecting lives, and ensuring the safety of the citizens of Islamabad Capital Territory during urban flash flooding and other water-relate emergencies.

### **AUCTION OF G-9 ISLAMABAD BUS STAND**

37. **\*Ms. Naeema Kishwer Khan:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the details of the auction of the G-9, Islamabad Bus Stand and other Bus Stands, alongwith details of the auction amount thereof; and*
  
- (b) *the amount spent on repair and maintenance during the last three years and the reasons for the dilapidated condition of the G-6, Islamabad Bus Stand?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) It is submitted that the two intercity bus/coach stands, namely Bus Stand at G-9 Markaz and Bus Stand at I-11 (Mandi Morr) are under the administrative control of the Directorate of Municipal Administration (DMA), Metropolitan Corporation Islamabad (MCI).

Both the aforesaid bus stands have been successfully auctioned through a transparent and competitive bidding process in accordance with the applicable rules and procedures. The details of the auction are as under. It is pertinent to mention that, through auction, DMA has generated 132% higher revenue compared to the revenue recovered under the self-collection mechanism.:-

(b) The bus stands under the administrative control of Directorate of Municipal Administration (DMA), Metropolitan Corporation Islamabad (MCI) were being operated on a self-sustaining basis before auction. Accordingly, repair and maintenance works are carried out from time to time on a need-based basis using funds generated from the respective bus stands themselves. No expenditure from the Government exchequer has been incurred on repair and maintenance during the last three (03) years.

With regard to Bus Stand G-6, Islamabad, it is designated as an intra-city bus stand primarily meant for local wagon routes. Over time, the site had been encroached upon by unauthorized occupants and was being misused as an illegal parking stand. Subsequently, the Directorate of Municipal Administration (DMA), through the assignment of a special task, cleared the bus stand of all encroachments and illegal parking and initiated a self-collection mechanism. Moreover, following the commencement of the Metro Bus, Green Line, and Blue Line services in Islamabad, the majority of local wagon routes have been discontinued, except for a few residual routes.

As the G-6 Bus Stand is being operated on a self-sustaining basis. Owing to reduced operations and limited revenue generation, repair and maintenance works are carried out from time to time on a need-based basis using funds generated from the respective bus stands themselves. No expenditure from the government exchequer has been incurred on repair and maintenance.

## **IMPROVE PAKISTAN'S PASSPORT RANKING**

38. **\*Ms. Sehar Kamran:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether the Government has taken notice of Pakistan's ranking at 91st position globally, tied with Somalia, in latest international Passport index, alongwith the specific factors contributing to the country's overall, low score;*
- (b) the measures being taken by the Government to improve Pakistan's Passport ranking, particularly with regard to visa free or visa on arrival access, global perception of Pakistani travelers and personal freedom indicators; and*
- (c) whether the Government has engaged with foreign Governments and international bodies to enhance mobility, ease of travel and international standing of Pakistani Passport holders; if so, the details thereof?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) It is submitted that according to The Henley Passport Index 2026, Pakistani Passport currently ranked 98th position worldwide (Annex-A) and is not tied with Somalia.

The aforesaid ranking represents a significant improvement over the earlier ranking of 103rd (Annex-B), which reflects a positive upward trend in Pakistan's passport ranking

The Henley Passport Index 2026 is based on the following specific factors, and weak performance in any of these areas may adversely impact the overall passport ranking.

- ❖ Visa free access
- ❖ International taxation laws

- ❖ Dual Citizenship
- ❖ Personal Freedom
- ❖ Political instability
- ❖ Security and economic challenges
- ❖ Diplomatic relations

(b) The Directorate General, Immigration & Passports under the ambit of Ministry of Interior & Narcotics Control has undertaken following important steps for improvement in Pakistan's passport ranking :-

- **Modernization of the Passport Personalization System**
  - Deployment of new state-of-the-art facility for e-Passport personalization system.
  - Advanced security features incorporated in e-passport booklet (polycarbonate data page and embedded microchips containing biometrics of the passport holders) to prevent forgery.
  - The current Machine Readable Passport is being gradually shifted to e-Passport in compliance with ICAO standards which will pave the way for utilization of e-Gate facility national and international levels.
- **Strengthening Passport Security Mechanisms**
  - Lamination features significantly enhanced and periodic changes to prevent forgery.
  - Advanced Passport (MRP & e-Passport) Booklet is being redesigned and prepared with following secured features:
    - o Laser engraving data and secure electronic chips fully compliant with International Civil Aviation Organization (ICAO) latest standards.

- o Visa pages having images of various Pakistan monuments.
- o IPI Jura feature addition proposed in new e-Passports.
- o Mother's name addition in juvenile's passports.
- Mandatory biometric-based Child Registration Certificates (CRC) for minors above 10 years, to reduce chances of child smuggling, and authentication of the personal credentials.
- **Visa-Free Access**
  - Pakistan has established Visa Abolition/Exemption agreement with 50 countries for holders of diplomatic and official passports (**Annex-C**).
  - Another initiative has been undertaken for further visa abolition arrangements with other foreign countries, which will also enhance diplomatic engagement and facilitate level.
  - Moreover, 32 countries grant visa-free/ visa-on-arrival entry to holders of all categories of passports, to enhance international travelling experience of the Pakistani citizens.
- **Policy reforms.**
  - The integrated digital dashboard, "Secure Hybrid Intelligence for Knowledge-Based Response Analytics" (SHIKRA), enables real-time monitoring of passport printing, delivery processes and overall operational activities country-wide, it also help for evaluation of HR deployed country-wide and at Missions abroad.
  - A comprehensive cyber security audit was conducted by the National Telecommunication and Information

Technology Security Board (NTISB), and (NCERT) along with (LEAs).

(c) Collectively, these measures have led to a notable Improvement in the international ranking of the Pakistani passport.

Simultaneously, the Government of Pakistan has strengthened engagement with foreign governments and international bodies through dual nationality agreements with 22 countries (**Annex-D**), aimed at enhancing global mobility for Pakistani passport holders worldwide.

Whereas 2.46 km has already been carpeted and 1.67km TST work has already been completed. However estimate of remaining 2.34km has been forwarded for principle approval. The remaining work will be undertaken with fulfillment of all codal formalities.

(b) All providing basic facilities street lights, water supply and sewerage lines will be undertaken after completion formalities of codal formalities.

(c) The remaining work will be undertaken after completion of following codal formalities.

- i. Principle approval
- ii. Technical Section.
- iii. NIT & Tender approval.
- iv. Allocation of funds.

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state the names of the persons who deposited the license fee for issuance of arms license with the Ministry and waiting for demand notices/issuance of licenses since 2023?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** There are Two Thousand Eight Hundred and Sixty Four (2864) licences which were paid of by the applicants in 2023 and are still pending at NADRA due to the Ban on the Prohibited Bore weapon licences. The Break up is as under:

### **ESTABLISH THE ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATIONS AT ISLAMABAD**

46. **\*Mr. Anjum Aqeel Khan:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state the steps being taken by the Government to establish the electric vehicle charging stations in Government, commercial buildings and other areas in the Capital Territory of Islamabad?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** Capital Development Authority (CDA) has undertaken regulatory and implementation measures to facilitate the establishment of Electric Vehicle (EV) charging infrastructure in the Islamabad Capital Territory.

CDA has notified and implemented the Islamabad Electric Vehicle Infrastructure Policy (IEVIP), which provides a regulatory framework for planning, installation, and operation of EV charging stations in government buildings commercial developments, petrol filling stations, and other designated locations. The policy mandates EV charging facilities in new developments and encourages provision in existing buildings.

Furthermore, CDA has issued notices to all petrol pumps and filling stations in Islamabad for installation of EV charging stations in accordance with approved standards. Compliance is being monitored, and several

stations have already installed operational facilities, while others are under implementation.

Additionally, EV charging provisions have been incorporated into relevant building regulations and planning approvals to ensure phased citywide coverage and promote sustainable and clean mobility in Islamabad.

## **GOALS SET FOR THE PROMOTION OF SPORTS AT NATIONAL LEVEL**

47. **\*Ms. Asiya Naz Tanoli:**

*Will the Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination be pleased to state:*

- (a) the goals set for the promotion of sports at national level as per existing policy; and*
- (b) the details of mechanism established through which Pakistan Sports Board will ensure transparency in the utilization of funds alongwith the complete detail thereof?*

**Minister for Inter-Provincial Coordination:** (a) In wake of the 18th Constitutional Amendment, the subject of sports stands devolved to the Provinces; however, the Pakistan Sports Board (PSB) continues to play a coordinating and facilitative role in matters of national and international importance.

The PSB provides support for the preparation and participation of national athletes in national and international events, including training, coaching, logistical assistance, financial assistance to National Sports Federations, sports facilities, and the award of cash incentives to medal-winning athletes.

The Prime Minister has directed the establishment of a High Performance Sports Academy for the training of athletes on modern scientific lines. For this purpose, a Long-Term Athlete Development Programme has been devised, initially covering 10 Olympic sports disciplines, namely Athletics, Boxing, Judo, Squash, Taekwondo, Weightlifting, Wrestling, Tennis, Table Tennis, and Shooting, targeting the 2028 Los Angeles Olympic Games.

In addition, PSB is making arrangements for participation in the following forthcoming international sports event:

2026 Winter Olympics scheduled to take place from 6 to 22 February 2026 in Italy. 6th Asian Beach Games to be held from 22 to 30 April in China 23rd Commonwealth Games to be held from 23 July to 2 August 2026 in Scotland.

6th World Nomad Games to be held from 31 August to 6 September, 2026 in Kyrgyzstan 20th Asian Games to be held from 19 September to 4 October 2026 in Japan

7th Indoor and Martial Arts Games Saudi Arabia (dates to be announced)

Furthermore, the 14th South Asian Games are scheduled to be hosted by Pakistan in March 2027, with participation from sportspersons across South Asian countries. Hosting this international multi-sport event will provide a significant opportunity to promote sports development, enhance Pakistan's sporting image and encourage youth engagement in sports nationwide.

(b) The Sports Funding and Utilization Regulations Pakistan 2025 were approved by the PSB Board in its 34th meeting held on 25 July 2025 to introduce a structured and accountable framework for disbursement and monitoring of government sports grants. The Regulations define eligibility criteria, funding categories, and permissible heads of expenditure for national sports federations. They require submission of activity plans, budget estimates, and performance targets prior to release of funds. The mechanism also mandates proper maintenance of accounts, supporting vouchers, and periodic financial and performance reports. Provision has been made for audit, inspection, and suspension of future grants in case of misuse or non-compliance. Overall, the Regulations aim to promote financial discipline, transparency, and result-based utilization of public funds in the sports sector.

### **CRITERIA OF FINE SET RENEWAL OF ARMS LICENCES**

48. **\*Mr. Muhammad Moin Aamer Pirzada:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

*(a) the criteria of fine set for renewal of arms license;*

(b) *total amount of fine deposited, prohibited bore/non-prohibited bore; and*

(c) *the details of amount maximum and minimum fine depositors?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a), (b) and (c) One the licence expires, the first month is that of grace period in which no penalty is incurred. However, after the first month of the expiry of the licence, the licensee has to pay Rs. 500 every month during the first year of expiry.

From the second year, the licensee has to pay 2000 per month for renewal of the arms licence.

The total amount of fine deposited in lieu of renewal of PB (13,877) / NPB (18138) arms licences during the year 2025 is PKR 176,662,000.

The maximum penalty deposited in lieu of renewal is PKR 174,000 and the minimum amount is PKR 500.

### **MULBERRY TREES CAUSE RESPIRATORY PROBLEMS IN ISLAMABAD**

49. **\*Ms. Saba Talpur:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

(a) *whether recent tree felling, particularly in tourist areas of Islamabad, is in accordance with the original Master Plan;*

(b) *whether any scientific evidence exists that mulberry trees cause respiratory problems; and*

(c) *the steps taken to protect the green belts, forest areas and environmentally sensitive zones of the capital?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) The Master plan of Islamabad is a comprehensive document which deals with over all planning parameters and guidelines of the Capital city. The recent cutting / felling of allergy causing paper Mulberry trees from different areas of Islamabad is a Scientific decision backed by history taken in the public interest to protect the citizen of Islamabad from allergies caused by these trees.

(b) Yes these are a number of research paper from medical scientists and experts which suggest that Paper Mulberry is the main pollen contributor which responsible for respiratory illness among the masses during Spring season.

(c) There is already stringent legal and enforcement mechanism to protect green areas of Islamabad which include, Preservation of Landscape Act 1966, Forest Act, 1929, and Environment protection Regulation 2008.

### **MADE ISLAMABAD CRIME FREE CITY**

50. \*Ms. Aliya Kamran:

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether the Government is aware of the that victims of street crime, snatching, theft, and harassment in Islamabad who are being frequently discouraged or denied from registering FIRs, leading to severe underreporting;*
- (b) if so, the details thereof, including any standing instructions issued to police stations;*
- (c) what real-time crime monitoring systems, surveillance technologies and patrolling mechanisms are currently operational to prevent such crimes;*
- (d) whether their effectiveness has been evaluated; if so, the findings thereof;*
- (e) the number of perpetrators of these crimes who have been arrested, prosecuted, and convicted over the past three years;*
- (f) what concrete steps are being taken by the Government to improve police responsiveness and accountability by establishing independent complaint mechanisms for First Information Report denial, expand CCTV coverage and data-driven policing; and*
- (g) the further steps being taken by the Government to implement a coordinated security strategy to make Islamabad, a safe and crime-free city?*

Reply not received.

## **PROTECT THE RIGHTS AND WELFARE OF OVERSEAS PAKISTANIS**

51. **\*Ms. Samina Khalid Ghurki:**

*Will the Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development be pleased to state:*

- (a) *the initiatives that have been taken by the Ministry to protect the rights and welfare of Overseas Pakistanis, especially in "Gulf Region"; and*
- (b) *the number of Pakistanis deported during the year 2025 from Gulf Region alongwith reasons thereof?*

**Minister for Overseas Pakistanis and Human Resource Development (Chaudhary Salik Hussain):** (a) A number of initiatives have been taken by the Ministry of Overseas Pakistanis & Human Resource Development, through OPF, to safeguard the rights and welfare of overseas Pakistanis, particularly those residing in the Gulf region. Various incentives and facilities are being provided both to Pakistanis abroad and to their dependents in Pakistan. The existing schemes are continuously revised and upgraded to ensure efficient service delivery for the benefit of overseas Pakistanis and their families. Details of existing schemes and facilities are as follows:

### **Welfare Schemes for Overseas Pakistanis:**

- 1) **Financial assistance** to the destitute families of overseas Pakistanis in the event of death or disability of an overseas Pakistani amounting to Rs. 400,000/- and Rs. 300,000/-, respectively.
- 2) **Free ambulance service** for transportation of human remains and critically ill Pakistanis from international airports in Pakistan to their native town/village.
- 3) **Funeral Grant** of Rs.25,000/- for the needy and destitute families of deceased overseas Pakistanis (who died abroad) to bury their loved ones with dignity.
- 4) **Recovery of outstanding end of service benefits/dues** of repatriated and expired Pakistani workers from employers abroad.
- 5) **OPF Online Complaint Management System (OCMS)** and linkage with Pakistan Citizens Portal (PCP) of Prime Minister Delivery Unit (PMDU) for speedy resolution of complaints.
- 6) **24/7 Complaint Monitoring Cell (Helpline)** established in OPF Head Office for providing all possible assistance to overseas Pakistanis in terms of their complaints and its resolutions.
- 7) **Support Desks for Overseas Pakistanis**, at CDA One Window Facilitation Office, G-7/2, ICT Administration Offices, G-11/4 and a 'Complaint Cell' established in the office of AIG, Investigation & Complaints at IG Office, H-11, Islamabad for provision of exclusive services and redressal of complaints of overseas Pakistanis.
- 8) **Property Dispute Cells** established in Baluchistan (Gwadar, Quetta), Khyber Pakhtunkhwa (Buner, Manshera, Mohmand Tribal, Battagram, Peshawar) and in Punjab Overseas Pakistanis Commission, Lahore for resolution of property issues of overseas Pakistanis.

- 9) **One Window Facilitation Desks (OWFDs)** at all international arrival/departure lounges of major international airports in Pakistan to facilitate overseas Pakistanis and their dependents. OWFDs are functional at Karachi, Lahore, Quetta, Peshawar, Multan, Sialkot, Faisalabad and Islamabad airports.
- 10) **One Window Facilitation – NADRA and Passport Office** at OPF Head Office, Islamabad for issuance of NICOP, POC and Machine-Readable Passports (MRPs).
- 11) **Facilitation Desk** for overseas Pakistanis at Islamabad Police Citizen Service Center, Islamabad.
- 12) **NH&MP Facilitation Centre** at Driving Licensing Authority (DLA), H-8/2, Islamabad for issuance of international Driving licenses to overseas Pakistanis.
- 13) **Pakistan-German Facilitation & Reintegration Centre (PGFRC)** at Lahore and an Advisory Desk in Islamabad to cater to reintegration needs of returnee Pakistanis from abroad.
- 14) **Emergency Relief activities** to deal with crisis / unforeseen circumstances or evacuation/repatriation of Pakistanis from host countries.
- 15) **OPF Educational Institutions:** To provide quality education (Play Group to Intermediate / O & A level classes) to children of overseas Pakistanis and general public through 27 OPF Educational Institutions across Pakistan and AJ&K. In these institutions children of overseas Pakistanis have the first right of admission besides provision of 50% concession in tuition fee upto four children.
- 16) **Provision of Scholarship** to the children/spouse of overseas Pakistanis studying in Intermediate, Graduation and Master/MS level.
- 17) **OPF Housing Schemes:** To cater to the housing need of overseas Pakistanis and to provide them residential facilities, OPF has initiated 12 housing schemes, out of which 07 have been successfully completed.

*In addition to the aforementioned, the following initiatives have also recently been taken in order to enhance engagement with overseas Pakistanis and facilitate resolution of their complaints:*

- 18) **Special Court** for Overseas Pakistanis property disputes has been formally established in Islamabad under the Overseas Property Act, 2024. The cases pertaining to property disputes of overseas Pakistanis are being heard/adjudicated by the special designated bench/judges in the Honourable Islamabad High Court and District Court Islamabad. Under the new law, special courts are being set up to address property disputes for overseas Pakistanis, ensuring their cases are resolved within 90 days.
- 19) In addition, **Punjab Government** has also passed 'The Punjab Establishment of Special Courts (Overseas Pakistanis Property) Act 2025. Balochistan Government is consider establishing Special Court for overseas Pakistanis, following the model adopted by the Federal and Punjab Governments. Other provinces Sindh and Khyber Pakhtunkhwa along with Azad Jammu & Kashmir and Gilgit-Baltistan are also being urged to establish similar courts to facilitate overseas Pakistanis.
- 20) **The first Annual Overseas Pakistanis Convention 2025:** The inaugural Overseas Pakistanis Convention 2025, organized by the OPF, took place in Islamabad from April 13-15, aiming to strengthen ties with the global Pakistani diaspora, address their concerns, and incorporate their feedback into policymaking. Over 1,078 overseas Pakistanis attended, and Prime Minister Shehbaz Sharif announced the creation of special courts in Islamabad to resolve expatriates' issues within 90 days, with similar courts planned for Punjab and Balochistan. The government also introduced investment incentives, including the restoration of the Green Channel for expedited customs processing and granting foreign investor status, alongside announcing civil

awards for expatriates making significant investments in Pakistan. This landmark event marks a renewed commitment to strengthening ties with Pakistan's global community.

- 21) **MoU with NAB:** OPF signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) with the National Accountability Bureau (NAB) on January 30, 2025 to establish a collaborative framework aimed at addressing issues faced by overseas Pakistanis. The primary objective of this collaboration is to establish a structured framework for communication and collaboration between OPF & NAB to expedite cases and to maintain a centralized record of all complaints forward by OPF, tracking their progress and resolution status.
- 22) **MoU with Pakistan Employees Association, Hungary**  
OPF signed an MoU with the Pakistan Employees Association in Hungary on 05.08.2025. The agreement aims to promote legal employment, ensure residence and visa facilitation, safeguard the rights of Pakistani workers, and support their voluntary and dignified return upon expiry of employment or permits.
- 23) **MoU with Metropole Laboratories (MPL)**  
OPF signed an MoU with Metropole Laboratories Pvt. Ltd. on 05.08.2025 to extend a 25% discount on all diagnostic and pathology services to OPF members and their families across MPL's branches nationwide. This collaboration is part of OPF's National Discount Program and is aimed at enhancing healthcare access and strengthening welfare support for overseas Pakistanis and their dependents.
- 24) **MoU with Anti-Corruption Establishment (ACE) Punjab**  
On 17 May 2025, OPF signed an MoU with ACE Punjab to safeguard overseas Pakistanis against land grabbing, property record manipulation, and departmental mismanagement through dedicated facilitation desks and focal persons, ensuring transparency and swift complaint resolution.
- 25) **MoU with Crime Control Department (CCD) Punjab**  
On 17 May 2025, OPF signed an MoU with CCD Punjab to address overseas Pakistanis' grievances, including property disputes, financial fraud, and misuse of authority. Dedicated facilitation desks and focal persons have been established to ensure transparency, accountability, and timely redressal of complaints.
- 26) **Civil Awards for Overseas Pakistanis**  
In line with the Prime Minister's directive during the Overseas Pakistanis Convention 2025, eminent overseas Pakistanis worldwide are now nominated annually for civil awards in recognition of their services. 16 eminent overseas Pakistanis have been nominated for civil awards in various categories on 14<sup>th</sup> August, 2025. These will be conferred during the Pakistan Day Ceremony in March 2026.
- 27) **New Incentive Package for Overseas Pakistanis**  
A comprehensive package of exclusive incentives has been launched for overseas Pakistanis and their families, including:
  - Next-Generation Membership Card (physical and virtual) with advanced security features
  - Accidental insurance coverage of Rs. 2 million for overseas Pakistanis, their spouses, and children
  - Priority access to OPF housing schemes
  - Special schemes for children (scholarships, laptops, scooters, and 50% fee discounts in OPF schools and colleges)
- 28) **Discount Program for Overseas Pakistanis and Their Families**  
A nationwide discount program has been introduced in collaboration with leading private sector companies. This program enables OPF members and their families to avail preferential rates in healthcare, pharmaceuticals, retail, hospitality, and diagnostic services.
- 29) **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** has been signed between the OPF and Islamabad Diagnostic Centre (IDC) to facilitate the overseas Pakistanis and their

families for provision of discounted healthcare services at all IDC facilities throughout Pakistan. They offered flat discount on 30% on lab and 20% on imaging for overseas Pakistanis & their dependents.

- 30) The Overseas Pakistanis Foundation (OPF) signed an **insurance agreement with United Insurance Company of Pakistan (UIC)** for accidental insurance coverage to overseas Pakistanis and their dependents. Agreement with United Insurance Company of Pakistan (UIC) for accidental insurance coverage of Rs.1Million to overseas Pakistanis and Rs.1Million for his family along with disability and repatriation of mortal remain.
- 31) **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** have been signed with “**Best western Premier Hotel Islamabad**” on 08/10/2025.
- 32) **Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** have been signed with “**Dental Solutions Islamabad**” 18/11/2025.
- 33) On 5<sup>th</sup> of January 2026, an **MOU was signed between Overseas Pakistanis Foundation & Hotel Hillview Islamabad** under OPF’s “Discount Program for Overseas Pakistanis & Their Families”.
- 34) **Nayab Labs & Diagnostic Centre signed a Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)** with the Overseas Pakistanis Foundation (OPF) in January 2026 to provide comprehensive, quality diagnostic services at discounted rates. This partnership aims to enhance healthcare access for OPF employees, overseas Pakistanis, and their families.

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether the Federal Government has conducted fire and safety audits of commercial buildings after recent fire incidents;*
- (b) the number of buildings found non-compliant with fire safety standards;*
- (c) the action taken against responsible authorities including penalties imposed or criminal cases registered; and*
- (d) whether a national fire safety frame work is under consideration of the Government?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Fire safety audit is in progress of all commercial buildings.

(b) A list of 80 high hazard building is forwarded by Capital Emergency Service of CDA to Building and Housing Control Dte of CDA for action under the rules

(c) Building and Housing Dte of CDA is issuing notices for compliance and in case of noncompliance sealing, penalty and other actions will be initiated as per rules.

(d) The Building Code of Pakistan, Fire Safety Provisions 2016 was developed by Pakistan Engineering Council in collaborations with National Disaster Management Authority, Government of Pakistan.

**NUMBER OF PEOPLE RESIDING IN KACHI ABADIS IN ISLAMABAD**

53. **\*Mr. James Iqbal:**

*Will the Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control be pleased to state:*

- (a) whether it is a fact that a large number of people are residing in various Kachi Abadis (informal settlements) within the territorial jurisdiction of Islamabad Capital Territory (ICT);*
- (b) whether it is also a fact that the residents of these Kachi Abadis are living in extremely poor and unhygienic conditions, lacking basic amenities such as clean water, sanitation, electricity, health care, and education;*
- (c) if so, the concrete steps being taken by the Capital Development Authority (CDA) or the Ministry to streamline and regularize these Kachi Abadis; and*
- (d) the short and long-term measures being planned to improve the living conditions and also provide the basic civic facilities to the residents of aforesaid areas?*

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Yes, it is a fact that a large number of people are residing in various informal settlements within the Islamabad Capital Territory.

(b) As per the decisions and directions of the Federal Government and the CDA Board, ten (10) Katchi Abadis in Islamabad were recognized during the period 1994-2004 for **up-gradation, rehabilitation, and relocation**. The Capital Development Authority has undertaken up-gradation of the recognized Katchi Abadis (to be upgraded/ rehabilitated at site) by providing basic utility services, construction of boundary walls, street widening, and ensuring improved access to the main infrastructure. All remaining informal settlements, are illegal and are therefore liable to be removed by the Enforcement Directorate, CDA, in accordance with the applicable laws and regulations.

(c) Since the informal settlements that have cropped up in the ICT are illegal and unrecognized settlements established on state land, CDA cannot take steps to streamline or regularize these abadis under the prevailing laws, rules, and regulations.

(d) Since the informal settlements cropped up in ICT are illegal and unrecognized settlements established on state land, CDA cannot extend civic, municipal, or utility facilities to their residents under the prevailing laws, rules, and regulations.

#### **CDA ACQUIRED LAND IN BHARA KAHU IN ISLAMABAD**

54. **\*Dr. Shazia Sobia Aslam Soomro:**

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Yes, in the year 1996 CDA decided to allot balance quota of CDA employees in sector I-8, Islamabad and list was also forwarded to FGEHA, who was allotting Authority at that time, but said formation to refuse to do so, hence some employees of CDA filed writ petition in the High Court which were decided in 2000, 2001, and 2004 by the High Court. CDA filed CPLA in the Supreme Court of Pakistan but after the decision of Supreme Court eligible employees were allotted plots in Sector I-8, in the year 2006-07.

(b) As Honorable Supreme court decided the matter and eligible employees were allotted plots in Sector I-8, in the year 2006-07.

(c) Since 2011, CDA employees' case for allotment of plots was pending in Islamabad High Court. No further action was taken due to pendency of court case.

(d) Matter was subjudice at court of Law. No further action was taken.

(e) Due to pendency of court case, no such list has been finalized.

(f) Due to pendency of court case no such list has been finalized.

**Minister for Interior and Narcotics Control (Senator Syed Mohsin Raza Naqvi):** (a) Property tax, being legitimate charges, is applicable to all housing units within the ICT limits including all housing societies.

(b) it is clarified that no restriction or delay in issuance of completion of completion certificates is link to property tax matters. Completion certificate are issued solely solely on the basis of completion or construction as per approved building plans, fulfillment of structural and safety requirement, and payment of prescribed scrutiny/Inspection fees in accordance with the ICT Building Control Regulations-2020 (as amend 2023).

(c) Property tax is livable to all housing and housing units within the ICT. Notices have not been issued.

(d) One residential house flat a apartment owned occupied (not on self hiring basis) by a retire Government employee whether in his own name of or jointly with his/her spouse or dependent minor children. This exemption shall be available if it is his/her on their only property in Pakistan and he/she or they are themselves living in the house or, as the Case may be, flat or apartment. This exemption shall also be available in case of death of the retired employee to the surviving spouse and minor children of the deceased employee. (In case of any one have another built-up property, the owner shall be entitled for 50% exemption on self-occupation). GPA having selling power is not entitled for any exemption.

Note: self-occupation rebate would be allowed only on current dues and arrears of last one year.

(e) Property tax is applicable to all housing units and housing societies. Notices are in process of issuance.
