ACT

to repeal the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation (Conversion) Act, 2016

WHEREAS it is expedient to repeal the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation (Conversion) Act, 2016 (XV of 2016) in the manner and for the purposes hereinafter appearing;

It is hereby enacted as follows:—

1. **Short title and commencement.**— (1) This Act shall be called the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation (Conversion) (Repeal) Act, 2026.

(2) It shall come into force at once.

2. **Repeal of Act XV of 2016.**— (1) The Pakistan International Airlines Corporation (Conversion) Act, 2016 (XV of 2016), except sub-section (1) of section 7 is hereby repealed.

(2) Notwithstanding the repeal of the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation (Conversion) Act, 2016 (XV of 2016), the conversion of the Pakistan International Airlines Corporation into a public company, all orders made, actions taken, arrangements entered into, transfers effected, licenses, permissions, sanctions, authorizations, concessions and approvals granted and all proceedings continued under any of the powers conferred or exercised under the aforementioned Act of 2016, together with any right, privilege, obligation or liability acquired, accrued or incurred thereunder shall be deemed always to have been lawfully and validly made, taken, issued, vested or transferred and shall continue to be in force.

(3) The particulars mentioned under sub-section (2) or in any other section of this Act shall not prejudice the general application of section 6 of the General Clauses Act, 1897 (X of 1897).
