WALKOUT

At 1.31 p.m. following the speech of Leader of the Opposition, he, along with some independent Members, staged a walkout from the House and did not participate in the subsequent proceedings.

REMARKS MADE BY THE HON. SPEAKER

Following the speech of the Leader of the Opposition, the Honourable Speaker made certain observations and that, as the custodian of the House, he would not permit anyone to make remarks that are detrimental to state institutions or contrary to the national interest.

The Honourable Speaker observed that the Standing Committees provide the appropriate forum for detailed deliberation and policy input on public matters. He noted that some Members do not regularly attend committee meetings for political reasons, yet seek additional time for discussion on the floor of the House. The Honourable Speaker further emphasized that Parliamentary Committees play a vital role in legislative scrutiny and policy formulation, and Members should actively participate in their proceedings.

Concluding his remarks, the Honourable Speaker observed that, irrespective of political differences, the House must demonstrate unity when matters concerning Pakistan and the national interest are under consideration.

At 2.08 p.m., Mr. Speaker adjourned the sitting of the Assembly to meet again on Wednesday, the 24th June, 2026 at 11.00 a.m.
