AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE
NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007

MS. NUZHAT SADIQ to seek leave under sub-rule (4) of rule 293 of the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007 to move the following amendments in the said Rules:-

1. Amendment in Rule 30 of the Rules of Procedure.- that in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 30.-

- (i) in clause (q) the expression "and", occurring at the end, shall be omitted;
- (ii) in clause (r) for the expression "full stop", occurring at the end, the expression "and", shall be substituted; and
- (iii) after clause (r), the following new clause (s), shall be added, namely.-

“(s) shall not pass any sexist, indecent or derogatory remark that may be prejudicial on the basis of sex, cast, religion, language, and culture”.

2. Amendment in Rule 31 of the Rules of Procedure.- that in the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, in rule 31, in sub-rule (3), in clause (j), after the expression "seditious, the expression" sexist, indecent, derogatory, shall be inserted.

**AMENDMENTS TO THE RULES OF PROCEDURE AND CONDUCT OF BUSINESS IN THE
NATIONAL ASSEMBLY, 2007**

1. **Amendment in Rule 30 of the Rules of Procedure.** - In the Rules of Procedure and Conduct of Business in the National Assembly, 2007, hereinafter referred to as the said Rules, in Rule 30.-

- (i) in clause (q) the expression "and", occurring at the end, shall be omitted;
- (ii) in clause (r) for the expression "full stop", occurring at the end, the expression "and" shall be substituted; and
- (iii) after clause (r), the following new clause shall be added, namely. -

“(s) shall not pass any sexist, indecent or derogatory remark that may be prejudicial on the basis of sex, cast, religion, language, and culture”.

2. **Amendment in Rule 31 of the Rules of Procedure.** - In the said Rules, in Rule 31, in sub-rule (3), in clause (j), after the expression "seditious, the expression “sexist, indecent, derogatory,” shall be inserted.

3. **Amendment in Rule 118 of the Rules of Procedure.** - In the said Rules, in Rule 118, -

- (i) in sub-Rule (1), for the word “ten”, the word “thirty” shall be substituted; and
- (ii) after sub-Rule (5), the following new sub-rule (6) shall be added, namely: -

“(6) A copy of every admitted Private Member’s Bill shall be communicated to the President’s Secretariat, the Prime Minister’s Office, the concerned Division, the Cabinet Division, the Ministry of Law and Justice and the Ministry of Parliamentary Affairs.”

4. **Omission of Rule 234-A.**- In the said Rules, Rule 234-A shall be omitted.
